

### The Glomerular Diseases

Syndrome	Manifestations
Nephritic syndrome	Hematuria, azotemia, variable proteinuria, oliguria, edema, and hypertension
Rapidly progressing glomerulonephritis	Acute nephritis, proteinuria, and acute renal failure
Nephrotic syndrome	>3.5 gm/day proteinuria, hypoalbuminemia, hyperlipidemia, lipiduria, severe edema
Chronic renal failure	Azotemia → uremia progressing from months to years
Isolated urinary abnormalities	Glomerular hematuria and/or subnephrotic proteinuria
