

It is the line (*plane*) running from the inferior border of the ala of the nose to the superior border of the tragus of the ear

Significance of the Camper's line: the plane of orientation for complete denture construction is established in the anteroposterior direction with the maxillary occlusal wax rim parallel to **Camper's line**, which is an imaginary line traced from the ala of the nose to the tragus of the ear, and with the **interpupillary line** in the transverse plane, which is an imaginary line drawn between the eye pupils.

Note: The **posterior determinants** of occlusion (*two-thirds the height of the retromolar pads*) have the greatest effect on the setting of the mandibular second molars.

Remember: The **Frankfort horizontal plane** is a horizontal plane passing through the lowest point in the margin of the left orbit (*orbitale*) and the highest point on the margin of the left and right external auditory meatus (*porion*). It is commonly used in orthodontics for cephalometric analysis.
